



Crossroads re-Imagined Camp
2nd – 11th August 2019
Kampos, Cyprus

Crossroads re-Imagined Camp takes place from Friday 2nd August until Sunday 11th August 2019 in Kampos village, in the district of Nicosia. It is implemented by the Association of Historical Dialogue and Research (AHDR) and funded by the Federal Foreign Office of Germany.

Crossroads re-Imagined Camp is designed for young people aged 15 - 18 years old and it employs, at the core of its activities, peace education methodologies, theatre and expressive arts, along with a multitude of other non-formal and informal tools. The camp aims to increase contact and cooperation between young people from all the communities in Cyprus and promotes reconciliation in the framework of a Culture of Peace and Non-Violence. When young people from different walks of life meet at *Crossroads*, we *re-Imagine* our perspectives to promote meaningful communication and provide a safe space for creative learning, democratic dialogue and mutual understanding and respect.

The camp process includes workshops, implemented by skilled educators and facilitators, using applied theatre methodologies such as devised theatre, as well as, dialogue and trust building activities. Participants can also work with other expressive art forms through visiting facilitators' workshops and experience outdoor activities like a day trip to the ancient theatre of Soloi.

Crossroads re-Imagined Camp will conclude with a final piece of work that exhibits the 10-day journey and interactions of the participants and showcases their learning process. The work that will be exhibited and/ or performed will be created by the participants, with the guidance of the facilitators.
